HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY



Fulcrum is committed to ensuring the health, safety and welfare of all of its employees.

We seek to conduct all of our activities so far as to prevent any injuries or harm to our contractors, clients and members of the public. All measures are taken to ensure that all of our statutory duties are met at all times. The Chief Executive Officer has overall responsibility for the management of this policy. Active involvement of the Executive team ensures effective implementation of the policy.

Every employee must co-operate with the organisation to enable all statutory duties to be complied with, at all times. The successful implementation of this policy requires the total commitment from all of its employees. Each individual has a legal obligation to take reasonable care for their own health and safety, and for the safety of any other people who may be affected by their acts or omissions.

The aims of our Health and Safety Management System are to promote continual improvement and:

- To comply with all current and relevant Health and Safety legislation.
- To ensure Health and Safety is an issue applicable to all staff and a key management responsibility.
- To allocate sufficient resources to provide and maintain a place of work that is, so far as is reasonably practicable, safe and healthy.
- To ensure that Health and Safety factors are taken into account in the purchasing, operation and maintenance of plant, machinery, tools and equipment, and in all activities carried out by the Company.
- To ensure that adequate information, instruction and training relevant to work and responsibilities is provided to all staff.
- To ensure that all relevant information related to Health and Safety is communicated to all persons engaged in the Company's operations, and to persons using the facilities of the Company.
- To ensure that suitable and sufficient systems and procedures are put into place for the safety of all persons at the Company's facilities in the event of an emergency situation.
- To ensure the provision of suitable first aid facilities and the availability of professional medical advice.
- To promote a Health and Safety culture and consultation through engagement and participation on Health and Safety matters.

Adequate facilities and arrangements are maintained to enable employees and their representatives to consult on, and raise, health and safety issues. The Company have appointed competent personnel to assist Fulcrumin meeting its statutory duties and, where appropriate, supplement this with external consultants and specialists.
